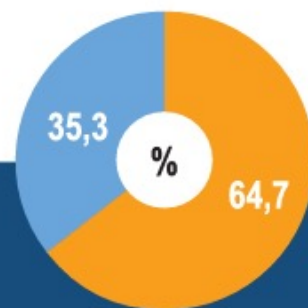

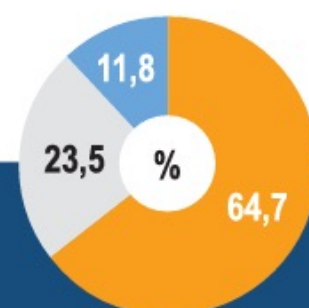
In the last six months, has your inventory of supplies been sufficient for the humanitarian assistance you provide?



Have you had access to fuel on a regular basis for activities requiring transportation?



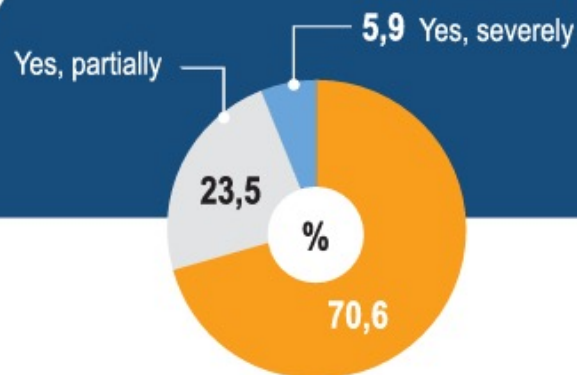
Have you regularly had safe passage or permits for the movement of personnel to the place of work or areas of humanitarian activity?



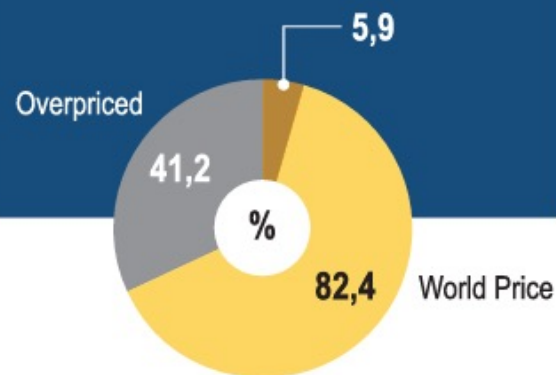

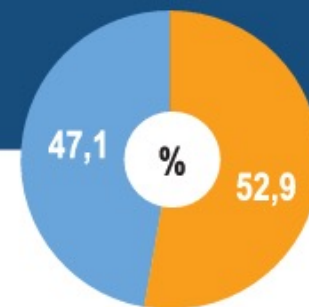

#### Impacts

Magnitude of the emergency in terms of impacts on the scale of humanitarian needs and damage to people caused by the collapse of internal capacities.

#### Response

Effective reach of people to a humanitarian response that is sufficient and adequate to their needs and rights, wherever they are and without discrimination of any kind.

#### Complexity

Circumstances and degrees of difficulty of the emergency due to the set of factors that limit, hinder or prevent the society from being able to support itself and recover as soon as possible.

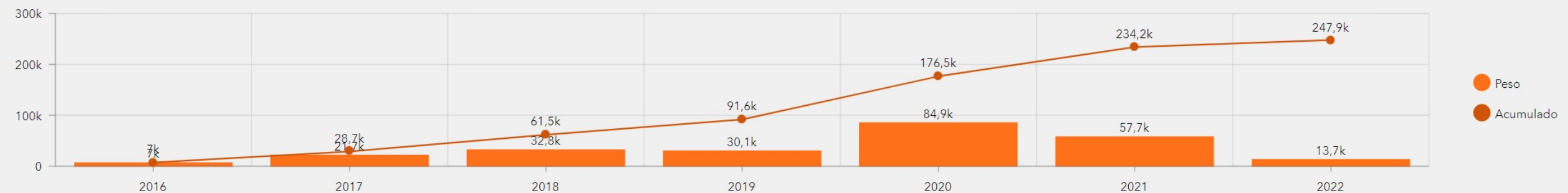

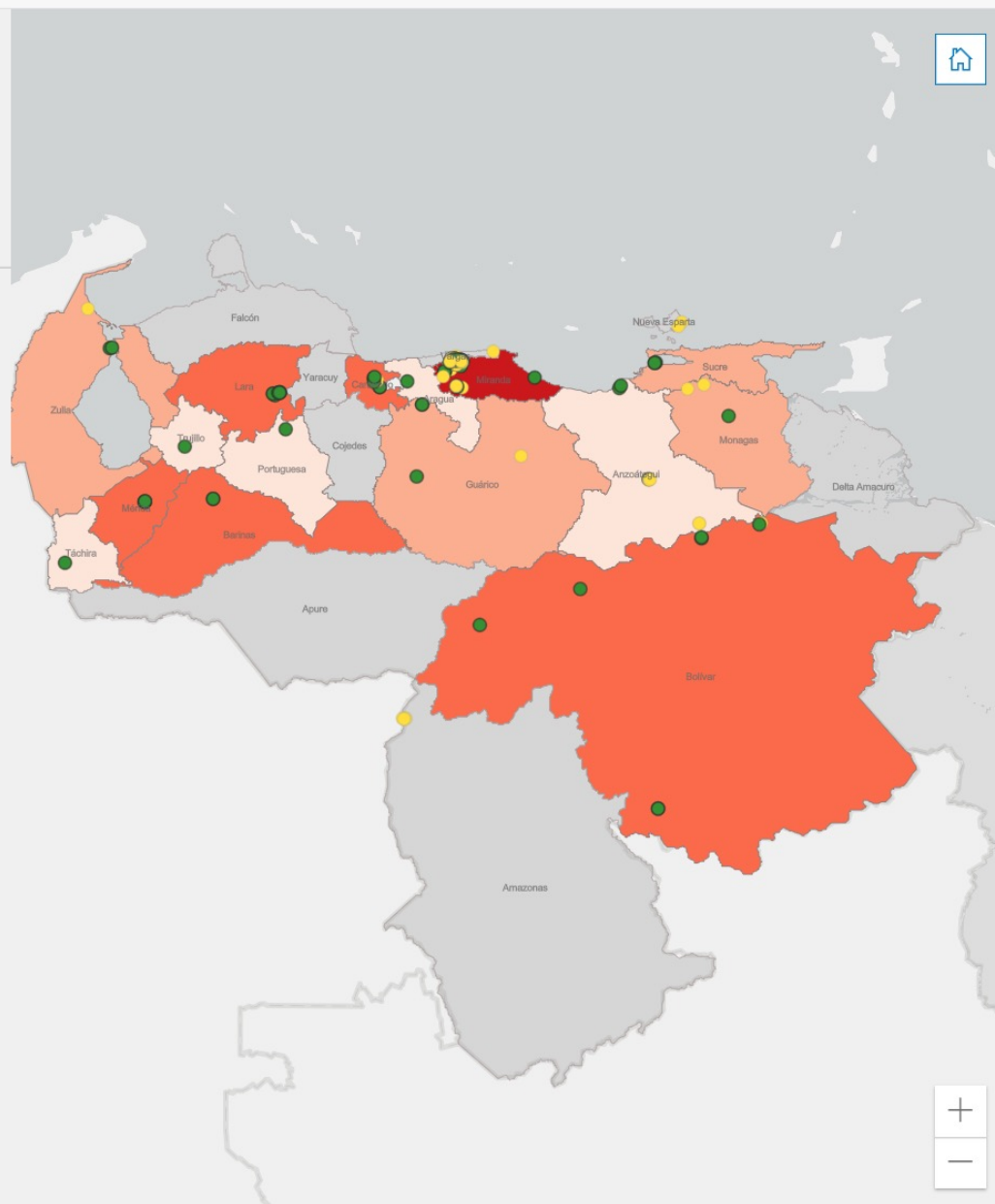

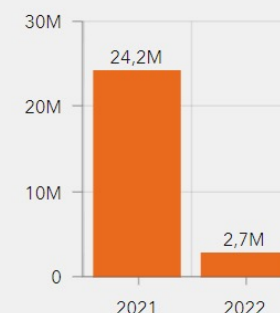

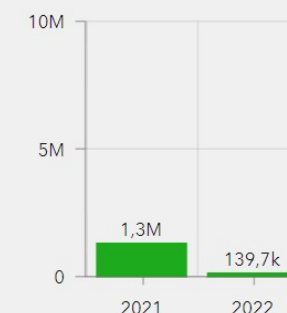

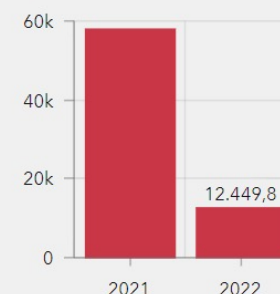

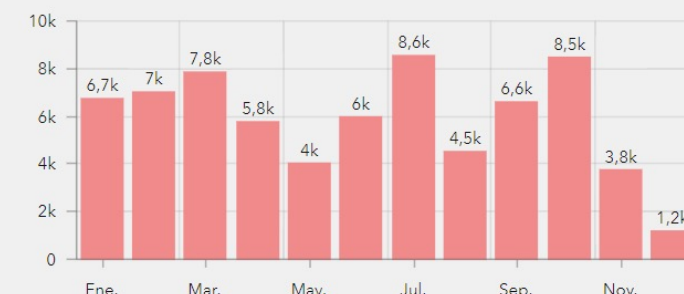

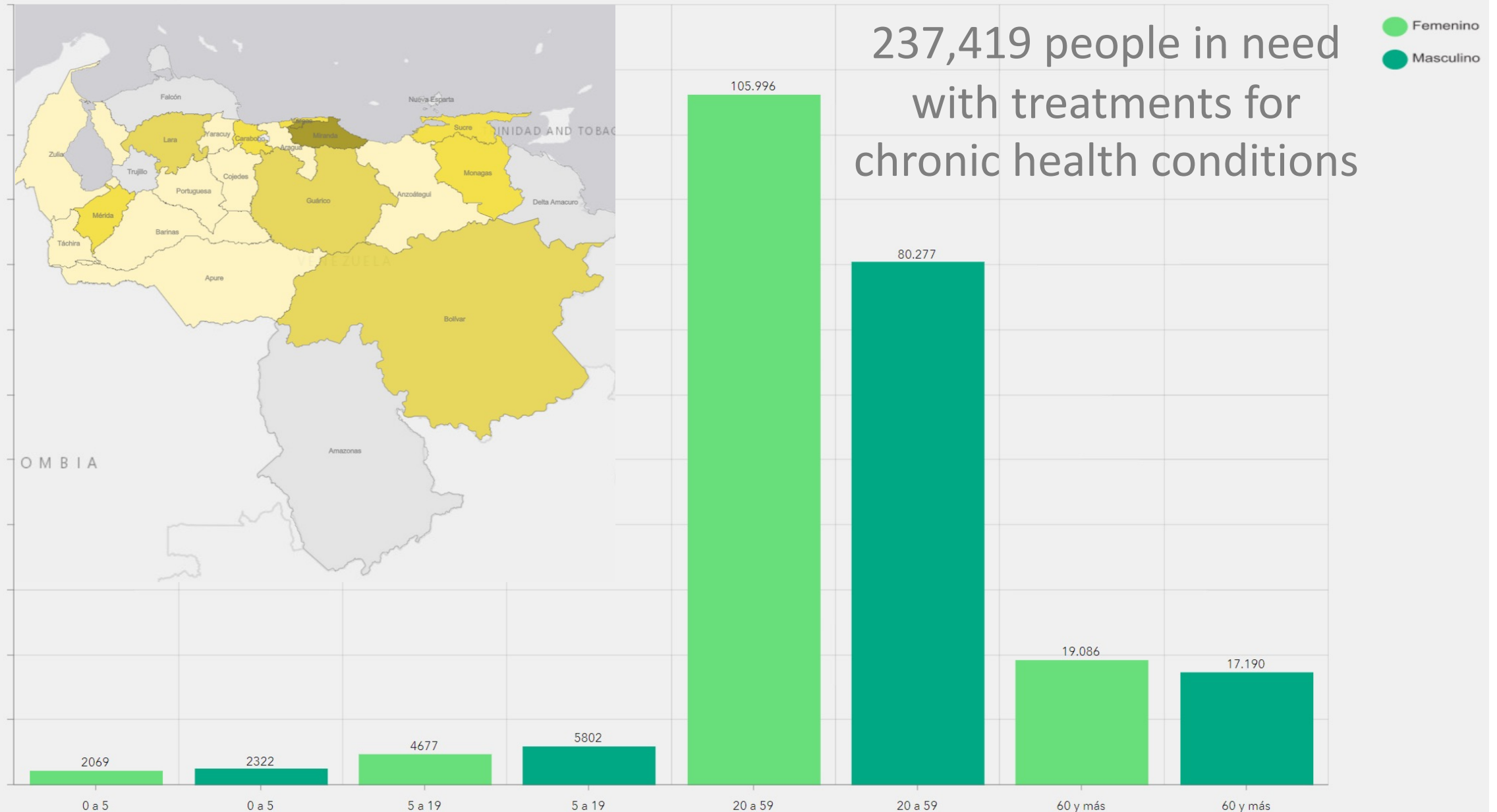

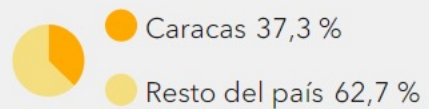

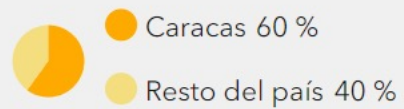

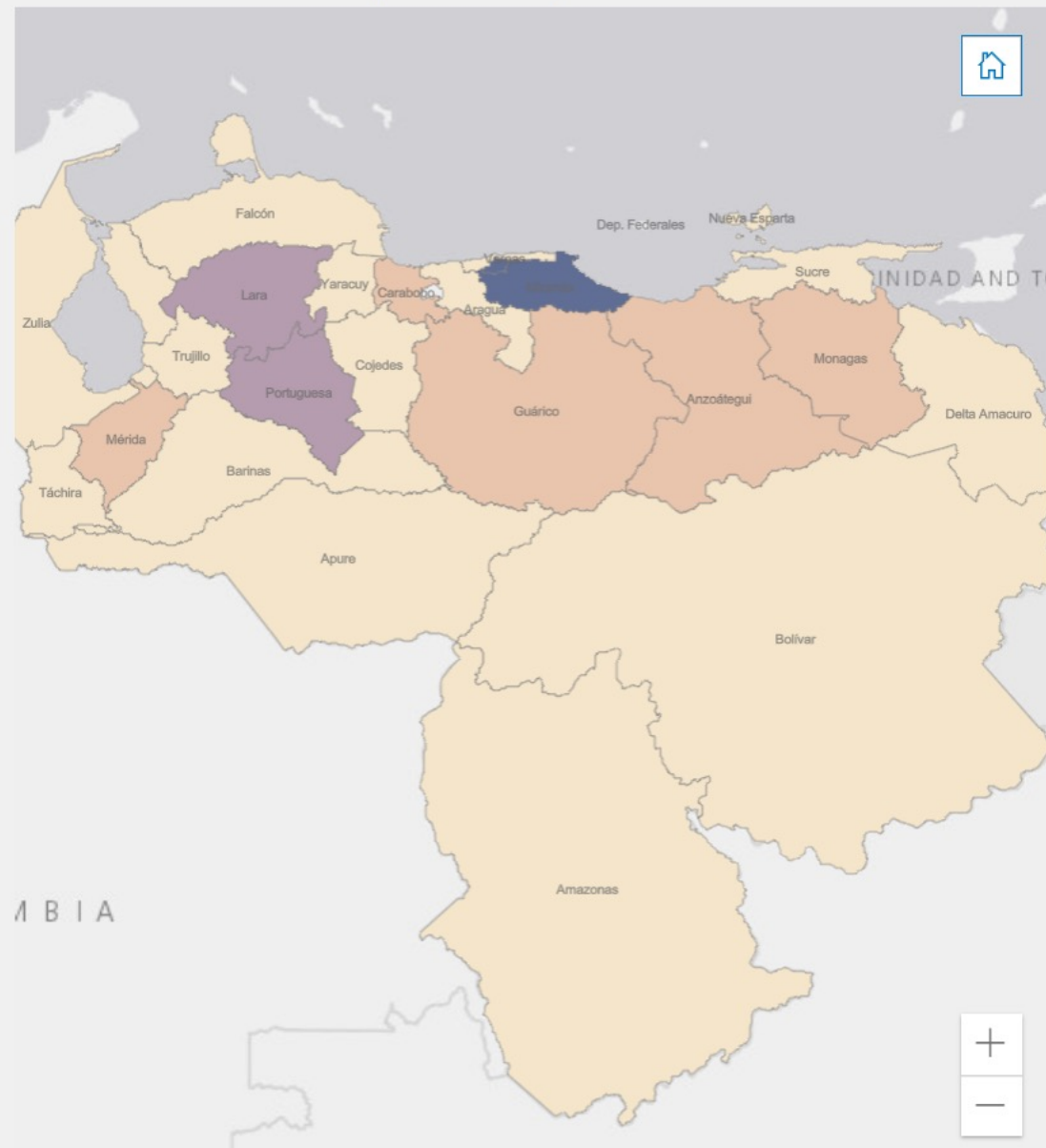

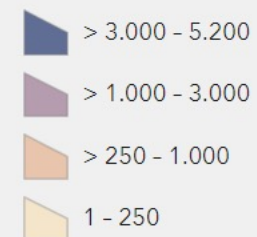


## Población con pruebas VIH por Estado de residencia





**5.4M** Migrants cross the border between Colombia and Venezuela



## PREVALENT RISKS

Multiple and systematic HHRR Violations

### People Trafficking

First destination department of women exploitation in Colombia.  
82% local rate of reported cases vs. national average rate of 63%

### Forced Recruitment, Scams and Shooting

Presence of criminal groups or guerrillas in the informal crosses



### Informal jobs and Irregular status

**92% migrants without any labor protection**

**From February 2021 onwards**, people who enter Colombia **without documentation** or through informal crosses will be in an irregular migratory status, so **unprotected**

### Minors excluded from basic protection systems



**76%** of migrant minors do not have **health insurance coverage**, compared to 3% of Colombian minors. <sup>\*1</sup>



**23%** of migrant children aged 5-17 **do not attend an education institution** for the following reasons: lack of **PEP**, lack of **capacity** of education institutions, other structural reasons. <sup>\*2</sup>



**7.69%** of children and adolescents aged 5-17 are involved in **child labour** in Norte de Santander. <sup>\*3</sup>



**5.8%** of children with moderate or severe acute **undernutrition** identified by Colombia's National Health Surveillance System are of **Venezuelan nationality**. <sup>\*4</sup>

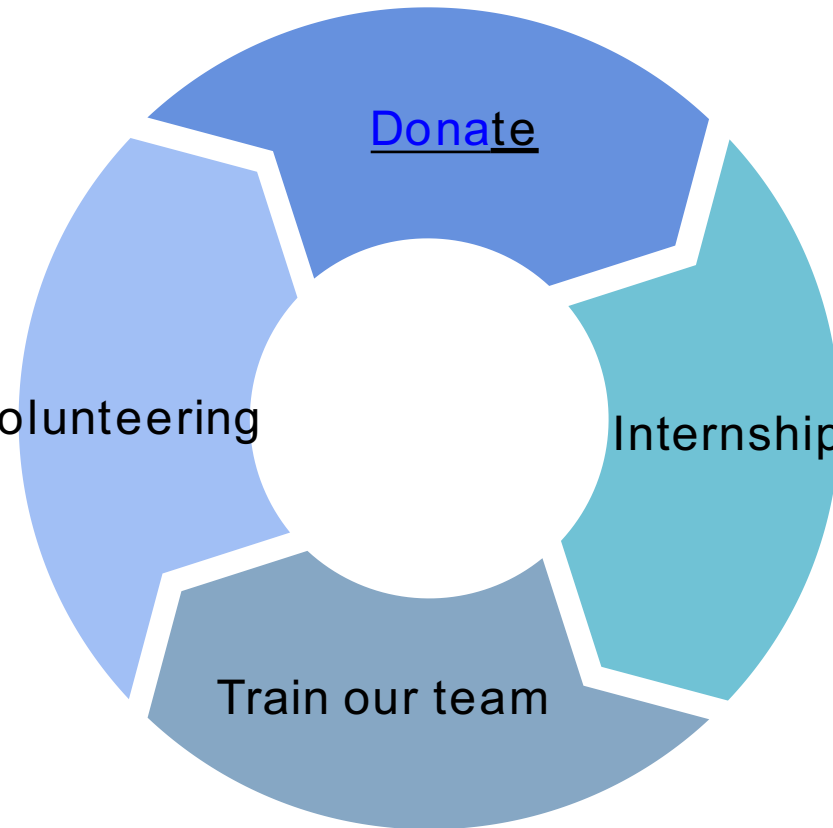


